

In this manual we describe how you can attach the Givt transmitters and what to look out for.

You can attach the transmitter in two different ways:

- (A) sticking or (B) hanging

To make communication about the Givt transmitters easier, each Givt transmitter has its own identity number. This is a sticker with a number (ED02:xxxx) on it.



- (A) **The collection medium has a smooth / hard surface**
(for example flat wood, plastic or metal)

NECESSITIES

Provided by Givt:

- Givt transmitter + sticker with number



- 1 Clean the surface of the collection medium.



- 2 Remove the film layer from the transmitter.



- 3 Stick the transmitter to a flat surface.

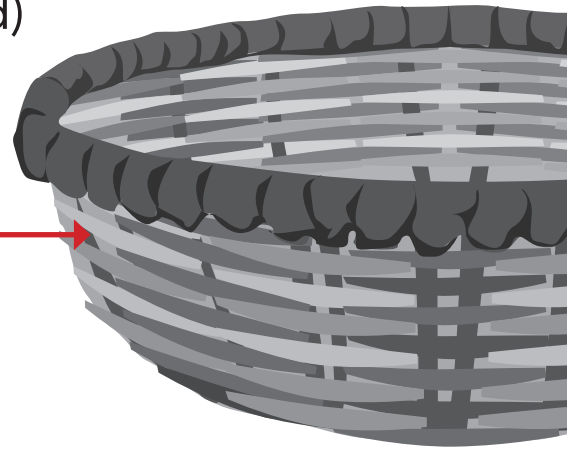
B The collection medium has a rough / uneven surface (for example reed)

NECESSITIES

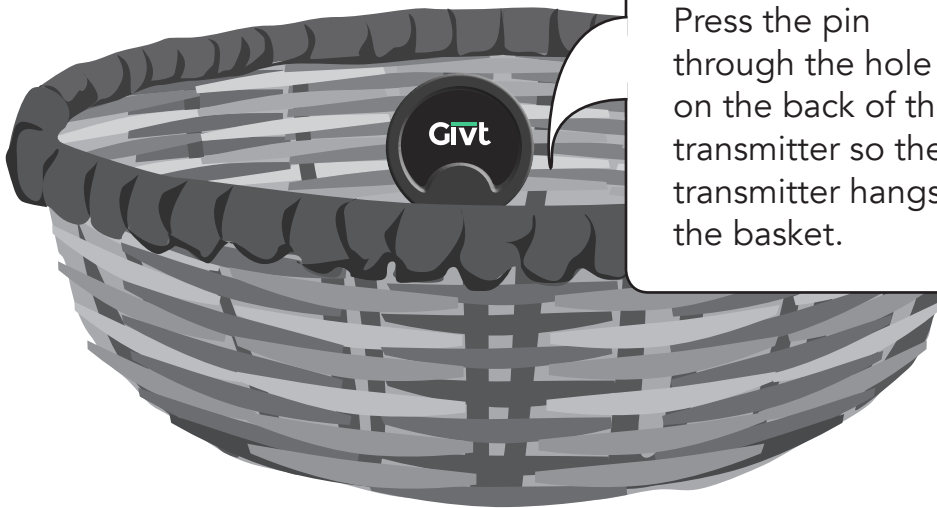
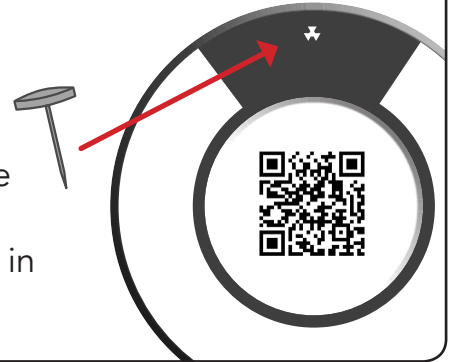
Provided by Givt:
Transmitter + pin



1 Insert the pin through the collection basket.



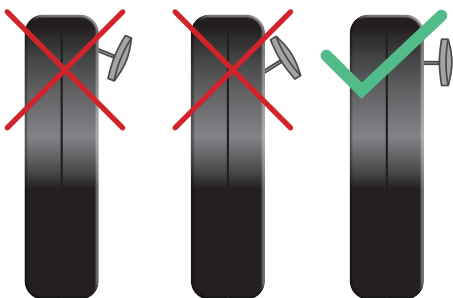
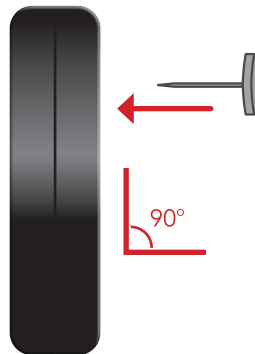
2 Press the pin through the hole on the back of the transmitter so the transmitter hangs in the basket.



! Important!

For an optimal result, the pin must be pushed perpendicular (90 degrees) into the hole. The hole is designed so the three corners bend with the pin, which makes it secure. Once fixed, you can no longer correct the pin.

Now press the pin into the hole. It takes force to place the pin properly. Do not use any tools for this.
